
Gentlemen:

The proposed Claiborne Enrichment Center seems to offer an answer to the problem of job opportunities in this area. The one percent school board tax would provide approximately \$5,000,000 over a four year period. With high unemployment, the high paying jobs available will be welcome not only to Claiborne Parish, but also to the surrounding region.
