Subject: Transmittal of Emergency Planning Information

Members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff appeared before your Board on July 26, 1982, to address items of concern regarding licensing of the Midland nuclear plant. The Board expressed a great deal of interest in the subject of emergency planning and preparedness as related to the Midland plant. This letter transmits several documents which our staff believes will enhance your understanding of the emergency planning process with respect to nuclear power facilities. Of particular interest is the role of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Enclosed are the following items:
