SUBJECT: ACCIDENT INVOLVING LEVEL GAUGE

Molten steel was accidently poured over a K-ray gauge Model 7060 SD containing 200 mCi of 137 Cs about 7:00 P.M., Wednesday August 25, 1982. These gauges are used for measuring mold levels. The capsule was not damaged except for burning off paint a.d labels. No radioactive material was released. This was confirmed by a survey conducted by State of Washington inspectors sent to the site that same evening. Considerable media attention occurred. The manufacturer's representative has restored the system to its original condition and the matter is closed.

Region V received notification of this occurrence from the State of Washington at 8:30 A.M. on August 27, 1982. This information is current as of that time.
