

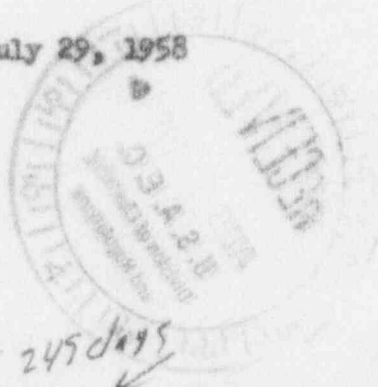

In August, 1955 we purchased 20mc of Ag-110 in the form of AgNO<sub>3</sub> solutions. This radioisotope was purchased under our purchase order 19354 and our Byproduct Material license number 27229. This license has been superseded by license number 34-1947-1.

We do not have any further use for the radioisotope and would like instructions on how to dispose of the radioactive solutions. We are requesting this information from your company since the radioisotope was originally purchased from you. The material is in liquid form and is contained in two glass bottles. One bottle is the original container and the second is a 2 oz. wide mouth jar.
