ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDING

I

GTE Sylvania, Electronic Systems Group, Eastern Division, 77 "A" Street, Needham Heights, Massachusetts 02194 ("the licensee") is the holder of Byproduct Material License 20-06852-02 ("the license") issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("the Commission"). The license authorizes the possession and use of byproduct material under certain conditions specified therein. This license was originally issued on June 5, 1973. The present expiration date of the license is July 31, 1983.

II

On December 31, 1981, the licensee's activities authorized by License 20-06852-02 and located at 77 "A" Street, Needham Heights, Massachusetts, were inspected by a representative(s) of the NRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement for health and safety purposes. On April 20, 1982, the Commission sent Invoice 0637P to the licensee requesting payment within 30 days of the inspection fee of \$390 required by 10 CFR 170 of the Commission's regulations. A second notice of payment due, together with a Notice of Violation, was sent to the licensee on May 24, 1982. A final notice of payment due was sent to the licensee on June 24, 1982.

The licensee failed to respond to three invoices. Consequently, on August 2, 1982, the Chief, License Fee Management Branch, Office of Administration, issued an Order to Show Cause ("the Order"), directing the licensee to show cause why the license should not be revoked permanently. As an alternative to filing an answer, the Order provided that, if payment of the fee were made within 20 days of the date of receipt of the Order, the Director of Administration or the undersigned would issue a subsequent Order terminating the revocation proceeding. In response to the Order, the licensee followed this alternative procedure and paid the inspection fee of \$390.

III

Accordingly, in view of the payment of the inspection fee under the terms of the Order and, pursuant to the Commission's "Rules of Practice" in 10 CFR Part 2, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This proceeding is terminated.
