NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial  
Hospital

License No. 24-16338-01

As a result of the inspection conducted on August 10, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 15 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced applications and letters.

The referenced application dated December 14, 1979, states in Item No. 7 that the responsibilities, duties and meeting frequency of the medical isotopes committee will be as described in Appendix B, of the "Guide for Preparation of Applications for Medical Programs," Regulatory Guide 10.8, dated January, 1979.


Appendix B of Regulatory Guide 10.8 states that the medical isotopes committee shall meet as often as necessary to conduct its business but not less than once each calendar quarter.

Contrary to this requirement, your medical isotopes committee failed to meet in the second, third and fourth quarters of 1980; the second, third and fourth quarters of 1981; and the first and second quarters of 1982.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
