NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Fairview General Hospital

License No. 34-02162-01

As a result of the inspection conducted on July 28, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified:

Condition No. 16 of your license requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in various dated applications and letters.

Your letter, with attachment, dated October 28, 1980, Item 14, requires that D.O.T. Yellow II labeled packages be surveyed at the package surface and at three feet from the package and a record be kept of the survey results.

Contrary to this requirement, no record of surveys for D.O.T. Yellow II labeled packages have been maintained since inception of this requirement.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
