Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Wm. D. Kelley of this office on March 8-12, 1982, of your facility at Wrentham, Massachusetts, associated with the manufacture of nuclear valves and to the discussions of our findings with Mr. W. Greenlaw and members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

This inspection was made as a result of the issuance of a 10 CFR Part 21 report by the General Electric Company, Nuclear Power Systems Division, concerning the failure of the Crosby Valve & Gage Company safety relief valves to demonstrate compliance with IEEE-323-1974 environmental qualification test requirements. These valves have been furnished to: (1) Tennessee Valley Authority-Hartsville Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 4, and Phipps Bend Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2; (2) Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company-William H. Zimmer Nuclear Station, Unit 1; (3) Commonwealth Edison Company-La Salle County Station, Units 1 and 2; (4) Pennsylvania Power & Light Company-Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Unit 1; and (5) Washington Public Power Supply System-Nuclear Project, 2.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of an examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, we found no instance where you failed to meet NRC requirements.

Consistent with section 2.790(b)(1), any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a full statement of the reasons on the basis which it is claimed that the information should be withheld from public disclosure. This section further requires the statement to address with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR Part 2.790(b)(4). The information sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a separate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
