Dear Mr. Bainor:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 2 to export license XMATO387 which authorizes the export of an additional 50,000 kilograms of nuclear grade graphite to Fuji Electric Company, Ltd., in Japan, for use as reflector material in the JAERI HTTR reactor. The total quantity of nuclear grade graphite now authorized for export under this license is 378,035 kilograms.

Inasmuch as the additional 50,000 kilograms of graphite authorized for export under Amendment No. 2 is to replace graphite which did not meet specifications or which was damaged during final machining and unusable at the HTTR, we ask that you advise us of the final disposition of the unusable material and the name of the Japanese company that receives the material for non-nuclear applications or for disposal as scrap.
