Dear Mr. Grobe:

- 1.) The reason for the violation was that in 1985 we sent in an amendment request to add a number of physicians as authorized users to our license. Two of these physicians were not listed in the amendment and this was not detected.
- 2.) The corrective steps that have been taken are:
The physicians not listed as authorized users will not work as authorized users until an amendment listing them as authorized users is received.

A letter, dated January 10, 1994, requesting an amendment to list these physicians as authorized users has been typed and will be sent as soon as a check is released to cover the amendment fee.
- 3.) The corrective step that will be taken to avoid further violation is that when we receive this and all future amendments we will more thoroughly review it to be certain that everything is correct.
- 4.) Full compliance was achieved the day of inspection, December 17. As of this date, only the authorized users listed on our license will work as authorized users.
