SUBJECT: EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EXERCISE SCHEDULE FOR APRIL 82 THROUGH  
DECEMBER 83

This is in response to the April 21, 1982, exercise schedule planning meeting for power reactor emergency preparedness exercises for all Region III (NRC) licensees and for the Beaver Valley facility (Region I, NRC). Enclosed are (1) the exercise schedule by facility, (2) the exercise schedule by state, and (3) list of participants at the meeting.

The following matters were generally agreed upon at the meeting:


1. Any party wishing to change the date of an exercise shall secure the agreement of all other affected parties. The change should be confirmed in writing.
2. NRC Region III will participate in joint public critiques with FEMA provided they are held no later than the evening of the day following the exercise.
3. All emergency plans will be tested in a full scale exercise annually. A full scale exercise is one that tests as much of a plan as is reasonably achievable without mandatory public participation. Small scale participation of a state or local plan is permitted only if they are or have been tested in a full scale exercise during the annual period. This ensures that all plans (licensee, state and county) will be fully tested at least once per year.

In addition NRC, Region III suggested that the annual medical and fire drill not be included as part of the licensee's onsite exercise. The licensee should keep the Resident Inspector informed regarding these drills.

In closing, I would like to personally thank you and your staff for your cooperation in dealing with this difficult task. NRC and FEMA are appreciative of the fact that concessions were made in order to achieve the development of this schedule.
