
Dear Mr. Martin:

This letter is in response to notice of violation, Docket No 30-12747,
License No. 06-17434-01. The numbered paragraphs below correspond to
the item numbers in the Notice of Violation.

1. Dose calibrator test for accuracy, linearity, and geometrical variation have been performed. Additional testing is scheduled in accordance with the requirements of Appendix D, Regulatory Guide 10.8.
2. Generator elution and preparation areas are surveyed daily. Technologists have been instructed to perform this survey daily.

Compliance with Item 1 was completed on July 1, 1982, and with
Item 2, on May 19, 1982.
