Dear Ms. Robertson:

I have received your letter dated January 31, 1994, and it would not be appropriate for me to comment on your allegations. I can advise you that procedures for interested parties to intervene in adjudicative proceedings of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission are provided for in the Commission's regulations. The appropriate regulations concerning participation in any such proceeding are set fourth in Title 10, Part 2, Sections 2.714 and 2.715 of the Code of Federal Regulations. If a person or organization desires to participate as a party, they have to meet timing and standing requirements and submit at least one valid contention; if, instead, there is a desire to only make oral or written statements of positions on the issues, an opportunity to do so will be provided in the event a hearing is held.

It is hoped this information is helpful to you. I am advised the Code of Federal Regulations may be located as a resource publication in the public library system of any large populated area, such as Oklahoma City, or the particular Title can be purchased from the U.S. Government Printing Office, Superintendent of Documents, P.O. Box 371954, Pittsburgh, PA 15250-7954.
