Gentlemen:

My staff, in a recent conversation with Mr. Bob Pattison of Rio Algom Corporation, discussed the necessary details and content to be included in your renewal application which must be submitted no less than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of the existing license in order to meet the requirements of paragraph 10 CFR 40.43(b). Based on that conversation it is apparent that Rio Algom Corporation would benefit from having an additional period of 90 days to revise its license application to incorporate new licensing policies that the NRC has implemented since your last license renewal on September 1, 1977. The staff believes this action would be mutually beneficial, as it would significantly improve the overall quality of your application, enabling fewer license conditions, and would significantly reduce the staff hours required to review your renewal application.

Accordingly, pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40, Item 4 of Source Material License No. SUA-1119 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4. Expiration date December 31, 1982"

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

The effect of this amendment is to extend the expiration date of Rio Algom Corporation's license by 90 days to December 31, 1982.
