QUANTITY	DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES This license is amended to (1) revise the list of countries authorized to receive the material to include ALL destinations EXCEPT Libya, Iraq, Iran, North Korea, Kampuchea, Cuba, Vietnam, and Argentina; (2) increase the quantity of dispersed tritium authorized for export from 147,000 curies to 300,000 curies and (3) include the following conditions: A. Only the export of dispersed tritium incorporated in luminous sources assembled into gunsights and other devices for weapons systems is authorized; B. No more than 10,000 curies shall be exported per year to any one country; and C. No exports under this license shall be made to Libya, Iraq, Iran, North Korea, Kampuchea, Cuba, Vietnam, or Argentina.
