On July 29, 1982, a letter was forwarded to the Washington, D.C. address of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, containing the required annual Land Use Report for the White Mesa Mill. This letter was sent out under the signature of B. K. Reaveau, Radiation Safety Officer at the Mill.

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We are hereby resubmitting the Land Use Report to the Silver Spring address to assure a more timely arrival in your office. The body of the report follows:

- Extensive oil and gas exploration activities have occurred within five miles of the White Mesa Mill. Upon abandonment, all wells drilled for exploration purposes apparently were capped and sealed.
- Cattle operations continue around the mill site, but only for two to three months each year. Basically, the area about the mill is used only for winter range and operations are for cow-calf production. Seventy-five to eighty percent of the annual calf crop is sold on open markets as far away as Kansas City and Omaha.
- Except for the above referenced exploration activity, the surrounding land use remains essentially as previously reported.

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
