ORDER

On October 14, 1980, this Board instructed the NRC Staff and the Licensee to inform the Board whether there was an intention to pursue the application which is the subject of this proceeding. The Staff and the Licensee responded that there was such an intention. The Staff, in its response, estimated that its Safety Evaluation Report and its Environmental Impact Appraisal or Statement would be published in May of 1981. However, neither of these documents has yet been published.

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This long period of inaction indicates that there is no longer any intention to pursue the application. Accordingly, the Staff and the Licensee are hereby instructed to inform the Board, not later than August 20, 1982, why this proceeding should not be removed from the Board's docket.
