This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mark Mitchell of this office on August 12, 1993, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 12-11702-02, and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated March 29, 1984, regarding violations found during our January 25 and 26, 1984 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required.

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NOTICE OF VIOLATION

During an NRC inspection conducted on August 12, 1993, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C the violation is listed below:

License Condition 19.B. of License No. 12-11702-02 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in the letter dated August 12, 1987. Item 22 of the letter dated August 12, 1987, requires that the sewer rod containing 45 millicuries of cobalt-60 and the 15 portable surface density gauges containing 3 millicuries of cesium-137, will be stored in the block house described by the enclosed floor plan. This floor plan is located at 11941 Waveland Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois.

Contrary to the above, since approximately August, 1990, the licensee has stored the sewer rod containing 45 millicuries of cobalt-60 and the 15 portable density gauges containing 3 millicuries of cesium-137 at the facility located at 11931 Waveland Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois a location of storage not authorized by the license.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Gammie Nuclear Service Company is hereby required to submit a written statement or explanation to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III, 799 Roosevelt Road, Glen Ellyn, Illinois, 60137, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice of Violation (Notice). This reply should be clearly marked as a "Reply to a Notice of Violation" and should include for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation, or, if contested, the basis for disputing the violation, (2) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved, (3) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations, and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. If an adequate reply is not received within the time specified in this Notice, an order or a demand for information may be issued as to why the license should not be modified, suspended, or revoked, or why such other action as may be proper should not be taken. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
