SPECIAL RADIOLOGICAL SURVEY OF THE FORMER AEROJET FACILITIES IN SAN RAMON. CALIFORNIA

This letter refers to the special inspection and radiological survey conducted by Mr. H. Dean Chaney of this office and Mr. Jeff Wong of the State of California, Department of Health Services, on September 3, 1993, of the facilities formally occupied by Aerojet-General Nucleonics (also know as Aerojet-General Corporation Nuclear Division), a subsidiary of Aerojet General Corporation, part of The General Tire company, located at 3300 Crow Canyon Road in San Ramon, California. Messrs. Chaney and Wong discussed the survey indings with Messrs. Doug Clayton, Mike Nelson, and David Clayton of ONB Associates and Aero Turbine following the inspection.

The enclosed inspection report identifies the areas examined during the inspection. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of historical records, on site observations, limited independent radiological measurements, and interviews with former and current building tenants. Based on the results of this inspection/survey, several areas with fixed low level residual radioactive contamination were identified in Building 1. Building 1 was occupied by the Aero Turbine Company at the time of the surveys. No other contamination was found above current release limits outside of Building 1 or in the other facilities surveyed.

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No violations of NRC requirements were identified. The residual radioactivity found was determined to be above current NRC release criteria.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
