SUBJECT: INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-443/93-23

This letter refers to the announced inspection intended to promote public health and safety conducted by Mr. R. A. McBrearty of this office from November 29 to December 3, 1993, at Seabrook Station, Seabrook, New Hampshire. Mr. McBrearty discussed the findings with Mr. J. M. Vargas and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was directed toward the activities relative to the long-term erosion/corrosion monitoring program and its implementation as accomplished in accordance with Generic Letter 89-08 and licensee commitments and procedures. The inspection was further directed toward the temporary, non-code repair of Code Class 3 service water system piping in accordance with Generic Letter 90-05.

The erosion/corrosion monitoring program and its implementation is effective and the activities related to the temporary, non-code repair of service water system piping complied with the guidance provided by Generic Letter 90-05.


