Subject: RESTART OF H. B. ROBINSON UNIT 2

On November 18, 1993, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) made the decision to place H. B. Robinson Unit 2 in cold shutdown because of a concern with an incorrect core reload (see PNO-II-93-064). Having determined that CP&L satisfied the commitments of the associated November 19, 1993 Confirmation of Action Letter, NRC concurred with the restart of H. B. Robinson on February 7, 1994. The unit is currently conducting a reactor startup. NRC (Region II) will continue to provide around-the-clock restart coverage.
