SUBJECT: CHANGES TO THE COMANCHE PEAK PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN, REVISION 18,

AND THE SAFEGUARDS CONTINGENCY PLAN, REVISION 5

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated January 13, 1994, by which you transmitted changes to the Physical Security Plan and the Safeguards Contingency Plan for your facility.

We reviewed the changes in your letter and the attachments and found them to be consistent with the provisions of IO CFR 50.54(p) and, therefore, acceptable for inclusion within your plan with the exception of Section IO.I of the Physical Security Plan. This Section, as written, is unclear and appears to decrease plan effectiveness for the following reason:

• When "Equivalent Armed Responders" can or will be used as compensatory measures is unclear and appears to conflict with Section 2.3.8 of the Physical Security Plan concerning when Response Force Personnel may be used as compensatory measures. Accordingly, you are to follow your previously approved plan about this item. Please resubmit a corrected plan to maintain continuity and clarification. Should you wish to pursue changing the Physical Security Plan concerning the decreased commitment, you should resubmit the plan under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.90.

This issue was discussed with your Security Manager on February 8, 1994. He stated that a plan change consistent with 10 CFR 50.54(p) would be resubmitted as Revision 19. That change is to be submitted in 90 days.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.
