Enclosed with this letter is a report describing the results of a test performed at the AP600 PCCS Large Scale Test Facility. This Quick Look Data Report (QLR) summarizes the test conditions and measured data for test 221.1.

The purpose of these data reports is to provide the NRC staff with information on AP600 matrix tests of sufficient depth to enable early evaluation and analysis of test results.

The QLR contains Westinghouse proprietary information and is identified as preliminary. This information will be incorporated in the Final Test Report for each test. With the publication of the Final Test Report, the preliminary identification will be removed and a non-proprietary version of the Final Test Report will be prepared.

An electronic copy of the test data included in the QLR is provided as Enclosure 2 on a single 3.5" High Density Diskette.

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
