This letter refers to the telephone conversation on August 16, 1982, between A. F. Gibson of this office and you, concerning a number of violations of your license conditions and NRC regulations identified by our inspector, P. M. Chambless, during his inspection at your Big Stone Gap, Virginia, nuclear pharmacy on August 12, 1982.

Based on the matters discussed, it is our understanding that you will cease procuring or dispensing any radiopharmaceuticals until the following actions have been completed, to our satisfaction:

- Perform radiation surveys consistent with your license conditions and 10 CFR 20.
- Perform Mo-99 breakthrough tests on each elution from your Mo-99/Tc-99m generator, consistent with 10 CFR 35.14(b).
- Perform constancy checks on your dose calibrator consistent with Regulatory Guide 10.8, Appendix D, Section 2 to insure conformance with your license conditions.

In addition, it is our understanding that you will notify this office by telephone (Mr. John Potter, 404/221-5536) upon completion of the above items and obtain our consent before resuming operations.

Please note the reporting requirements identified above are not subject to Office of Management and Budget clearance as required by P.L. 96-511.

If your understanding of our discussion is different from that stated above, please inform this office promptly.
