Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter of Movember 14, 1958 in which you requested an amendment to your special nuclear material license to suthorize revised shipping procedures.

Before we may continue our review of your application you should submit the calculations by which you have determined that the fissionable material would not become critical:

- 1. If the shipping containers were arranged in an optimum critical array;
- If the elements were assembled in a more compact arrangement (this should include the H/U ratio you have assumed for these calculations); and
- 3. If the shipment were flooded.

You should also submit calculations determining the concentration required to achieve criticality under conditions of total flooding. If you have assumed other than an optimum R/U ratio in making any of the above calculations you should also submit a description of the pasking material you will use inside the shipping boxes.

The above information should be submitted in quadruplicate.
