Pryor Foundry, Inc. ("Pryor"), the holder of the above-referenced QA Program Approval (the "Permit"), has sold substantially all of its assets at its facility in Pryor, Oklahoma (the "Facility") to Grede-Pryor, Inc. ("GPI"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Grede Foundries, Inc. As part of this transaction, Pryor will no longer be responsible for the operation of the Facility and, therefore, desires to transfer the Permit to GPI. The sale from Pryor to GPI was effective as of 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 6, 1994. The operations and personnel at the Facility (including all aspects of the QA Program) will remain essentially the same, and GPI's business address will be that which is currently on file for Pryor.

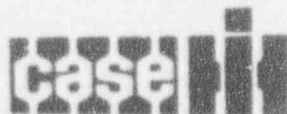
