Gentlemen:

As a part of our application for the subject license, we submitted to you Standard Procedure CR-15 entitled "Health and Safety ---Nuclear Frogram". This procedure applies to all nuclear materials processing at the Research Center, in addition to the specific use authorized by the subject license.

In the course of our nuclear materials processing activities, we have encountered a problem which necessitates a minor change in this procedure. Copies of the proposed change are attached to this letter.

The Ohio Overall Company, which is providing work clothing laundering service, cannot handle clothing with an alpha activity greater than 1500 disintegrations per minute per 75 square centimeters. We plan to send work clothing contaminated beyond this limit to Nuclear Laundry Service, Inc., Waterbury, Connecticut. The proposed change to CR-15 incorporates the above into the procedure.

Please advise whether the proposed change meets with your approval, and whether it can be made a part of the procedures relating to the subject license.
