SUBJECT: PROPOSED EXPORT OF COMPONENTS TO EGYPT (XCOM0237)

The Department of State indicated to IP staff on August 3, 1982 that General Atomic Company lost the order covered by their license application XCOM0237 because they could not ship the items on a timely basis. General Atomic confirmed this on August 5. General Atomic, however, is in the process of acquiring another order from Egypt for similar parts for the UA-RR-1 Research Reactor and still wants the export license so they can complete this shipment on a timely basis.

State has no objection to NRC issuing a license to cover this anticipated order.

Export license XCOM0237 was issued with the understanding that any new order for instrumentation for the UA-RR-1 Research Reactor could be exported under this license as long as the items proposed for export meet all of the license conditions.
