SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY -- FEBRUARY 17 & 18, 1994 NRC/NUMARC PUBLIC MEETINGS  
ON NUMARC PROPOSED RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS SUBMITTED DURING THE  
AUGUST 1993 NUMARC WORKSHOPS ON THE INDUSTRY GUIDELINE DOCUMENT FOR  
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MAINTENANCE RULE (10 CFR 50.65)

The subject meetings were held at the NRC Headquarters Offices. The meeting notice is provided as enclosure 1 and the list of attendees is provided as enclosure 2.

The purpose of the meetings was to initiate discussions regarding NUMARC's proposed responses to questions submitted during the two NUMARC sponsored workshops held in August 1993 on NUMARC 93-01, "Industry Guideline for Monitoring the Effectiveness of Maintenance at Nuclear Power Plants."

NUMARC received in excess of 700 questions on NUMARC 93-01 during the two workshops. Due to redundancy and similarities, the number was consolidated to approximately 450. During the February 17 & 18, 1994 meetings, NRC staff that had attended the NUMARC workshops reviewed each proposed response to the questions. All materials made available during the meetings by NUMARC representatives were retrieved.

In general, the staff felt that the responses were comprehensive and consistent with the guidance contained in NUMARC 93-01. Based on the discussions between the staff and the NUMARC representatives during the
