Dear Dr. Murley:

During review of the subject proposed license amendment, Mr. George Dick of your Staff identified a deviation between the proposed wording on Byron Technical Specification page 3/4 7-22 and Generic Letter 90-09. The proposed wording on the subject Braidwood Technical Specification page was, however, consistent with the Generic Letter. Commonwealth Edison Company, therefore, wishes to correct the proposed wording in the Byron amendment to be consistent with the Generic Letter.

Attachment A to this letter contains a copy of the affected Byron Technical Specification page (page 3/4 7-22) and the associated Insert A. The word "category" on Insert A has been changed to "type". Please incorporate this change into the proposed Byron amendment.
