On August 3, 1982, during normal operations, plant service water was lost due to closure of a secondary containment isolation valve which did not properly indicate its status in the control room. On August 4 another PSW isolation valve was manually closed to comply with T.S. 3.6.6.2. This valve also failed to indicate its proper status in the control room. Attached is LER 82-037/03 L-0.
