The Commission asked OGC and the staff to explore with the Organization of Agreement States the establishment of a committee under FACA that would alleviate the problems associated with asking the Agreement States for advice or recommendations. Staff, however, should also explore the feasibility of other approaches that were identified in Mr. Parler's February 4, 1994 memorandum to the Commission on this subject since a FACA committee may not be the only or the best solution for all situations.
