PROJECT, UNITS 1 AND 2 (TAC NOS. M87664 AND M87665)

By letter dated September 9, 1993, as supplemented by letters dated December 3, 1993, January 4, 1994, and February 8, 1994, you proposed changes to South Texas Project's emergency classification procedure. Specifically, Revision 3 to OERPO1-ZV-INO1, "Emergency Classification," incorporated revised emergency action levels (EALs) based upon NUMARC/NESP-007, "Methodology for Development of Emergency Action Levels," (Revision 2, January 1992). The staff has endorsed NUMARC/NESP-007 as an acceptable method for developing EALs as required in Appendix E to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR). Part 50.

Section IV.B of Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50 requires that EALs be approved by the staff. As a result of our review, we have concluded that the proposed EALs are consistent with the guidance in NUMARC/NESP-007, and therefore meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50.47(b)(4) and Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50. Our safety evaluation regarding the revision to OERPO1-ZV-INO1 is enclosed.
