

2. SLNRC 81-22, dated April 1, 1981

Reference 1 provided information on a potential deficiency involving operation of the centrifugal charging pumps following secondary side high energy line breaks. It was stated in reference 2 that design changes to correct the situation were still being evaluated by Bechtel, Westinghouse, and the SNUPPS utilities. At this time a final report is anticipated by November 1, 1982 pending completion of engineering and review of the design change.
