Subject: Management Meeting 50-320/82-10

This refers to the enforcement conference held on July 29, 1982, in the NRC Region I office, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania.

The subject meeting was held to discuss NRC findings and concerns involving control of safety related maintenance activities and management of corrective actions. The meeting was attended by the Regional Administrator, members of the NRC Region I staff, representatives from the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and by you and members of your staff. The topics discussed and the meeting results are described in the NRC Region I Meeting report which is enclosed.

Pertinent areas examined during a previous inspection were documented in NRC Region I Inspection Report No. 50-320/82-04, paragraph 11. Based upon these findings, and our continued review of these findings at the enforcement conference, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This violation has been categorized into the level described in the Federal Register Notice (47 FR 9987) dated March 9, 1982. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

After a careful consideration of the factors involved in this specific case and in light of your responsiveness to our concerns at the enforcement conference, the item described in Appendix A is classified as a Severity IV violation. Your response to this item should document the anticipated specific improvements in your management control system for safety related maintenance activities. Your reply should also contain the other corrective actions which you outlined at the enforcement conference and the dates when your actions will be implemented.

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The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1). The telephone notification of your intent to request withholding, or any request for an extension of the 10 day period which you believe necessary, should be made to the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, USNRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223.

Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.
