Gulf States Utilities Company ("GSU"), pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.714a, hereby appeals the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's "Memorandum and Order (On Petition to Intervene)," LBP-94-3 ("Order"), dated January 27, 1994. As set forth more fully in the Brief in Support of Gulf State Utilities Company's Appeal being filed contemporaneously with this Notice of Appeal, the Licensing Board, contrary to the requirements of § 2.714 and Commission precedents, ruled that Cajun Electric Power Cooperative, Inc.
