Dear Administrative Judges:

In a Memorandum and Order of February 1, 1994, the Board requested that the Staff inform the Board and parties whether the Staff will release the exhibits or attachments to the Office of Investigation (OI) report on diesel generator reporting by Georgia Power Company (GPC), by February 18, 1994.

In the "NRC Brief On Release Of OI Report Requested In Licensing Board Order of February 1, 1994," dated February 4, 1994, and the accompanying affidavit of the Executive Director for Operations, we indicated that the exhibits to the OI report would not be released at this time. In this letter, in compliance with the Board's Order of February 1, 1994, we iterate that we do not intend to release those exhibits to the OI report at this time.

On December 17, 1993, 45 tapes and 44 transcripts of audio recordings by Mr. Mosbaugh on the diesel generator issue were given to GPC. The Staff has provided copies of tapes numbers 57 and 58 and transcripts of those tapes to counsel for Intervenor. As we previously offered, we will provide Intervenor's counsel with copies of the other tapes and transcripts which were given to GPC on December 17, 1993.


