Inspection Summary: Routine Unannounced Physical Protection Inspection April 26-30, 1982 (Report No. 50-247/82-07) Areas Inspected: Included a Site Orientation; a review of the Security Plan and Implementing Procedures; Security Organization (Management, Personnel, Response); Security Program Audit; Records and Reports; Testing and Maintenance; Locks, Keys, and Combinations, and Access Control-Personnel.

The inspection involved 36 inspector hours onsite by one NRC region-based inspector. The inspection was initiated during regular duty hours; 4 inspector hours were accomplished during offshift periods.

Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC regulations except for the following violations: (1) Failure to maintain effective, protected area access controls, and (2) Failure to report the breakdown of protected area access controls to the NRC.

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
