General License (10 CFR 40.22)

Subject: ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND ORDER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING
LICENSE (EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY)

This is to inform the Commission that an Order To Show Cause Why The License Should Not Be Suspended and Order Temporarily Suspending License (Effective Immediately) is being issued today to Orian Chemical Company, Provo, Utah. This enforcement action is based on four violations: refusal to make available to an NRC inspector records of transfer, contamination in areas outside the licensee's premises, possession of source material exceeding authorized limits, and incomplete records of receipt.

Under the terms of the Order the licensee may, within 25 days of the date of receipt of the Order, file a written answer under oath or affirmation and may also request a hearing. However, a written answer or request for a hearing will not stay the immediate effectiveness of this Order.

A news release will be issued about the time the licensee receives the Order. The state of Utah will be notified.
