NRC Region I Special Inspection Report Nos. 50-317/94-05 and 50-318/94-05

(January 19, 1994 - January 21, 1994)

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. Wilson, Lyon, Lathrop, and Skokowski of this office on January 19, 1994, through January 21, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Calvert Cliffs facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. The inspectors reviewed the causes for the January 12, 1994, Unit 2 reactor trip and partial loss of offsite power. Other areas examined included plant and operator response to the event and BG&E's corrective actions. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements.

The NRC concluded that licensee actions in response to the event were prompt and thorough. Our review concluded that inadequate design instructions, communications breakdowns and inattention to detail resulted in the installation of a modification that was incomplete, not fully tested and adequately evaluated. This in conjunction with an electrical ground caused the above event. The lack of adequate design controls associated with this modification was a violation of NRC requirements as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Appendix A). Enforcement discretion for this violation was not exercised because the problem lead to a partial loss of offsite power and a Unit 2 reactor trip.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and include any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence.
