This letter submits an additional administrative amendment to NEDE-24011-P-A-4 (GESTAR II) to be included with the amendments submitted in the Reference 1 letter. This amendment contains an Initial Core Roadmap in the form of two new appendices to be added to the base document of GESTAR II. One appendix contains a Safety Analysis Report (SAR) roadmap while the other contains a standard SAR writeup.

This amendment has been classified by the GE review committee as administrative based on the criteria established in 10CFR50.59. These criteria are delineated for this amendment in the enclosed classification justification review sheet.

As stated in Reference 2, the NRC may agree, disagree, or not comment on a revision classification within forty-five days of receipt of this letter. The forty-five day period expires on October 18, 1982. If the NRC disagrees with the classification, the revision will be submitted for NRC review in accordance with the procedures identified in Reference 3. Should the NRC either agree or not comment within 45 days, the proposed revision will be implemented on the designated date. The page changes enclosed with notification letter will then be incorporated into the LTR and the LTR reissued.


