In accord with the provisions of Condition 12, Amendment No. 15 of our license, the Babcock & Wilcox Company, Commercial Nuclear Fuel Plant encloses seven (7) copies of revised Pages 4-2 and 5-16 of our Radiological Contingency Plan.

Page 4-2 was revised to change the designated Security Officer and his alternate. The change was necessary to match the normal staff functions with emergency functions.

Page 5-16 was revised to change the configuration of the designated muster area. The change enables the control person to maintain better communications with the people in the muster area.

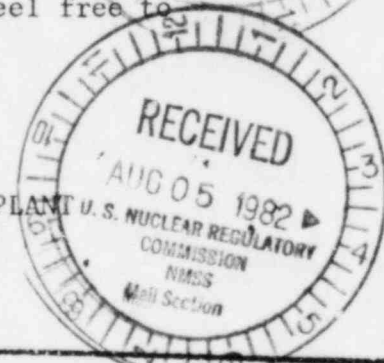
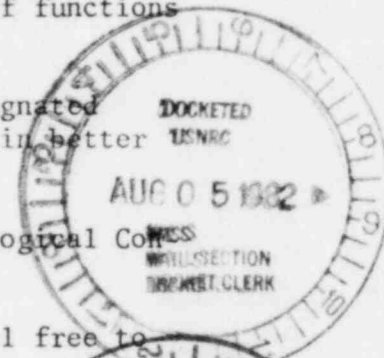
The revisions do not decrease the effectiveness of our Radiological Contingency Plan.
