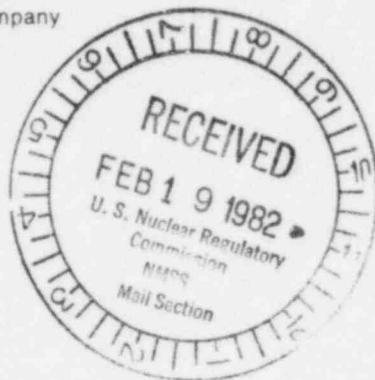

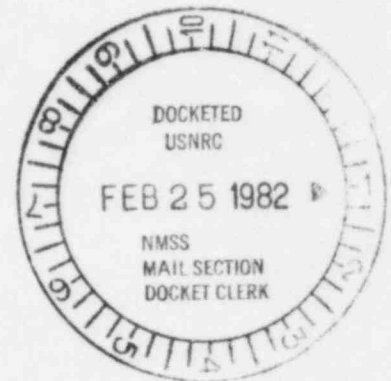

Gentlemen:

In reference (b) I requested an extension of the reporting interval specified in 10 CFR 70.51(e)(4)(i) for the inventory period which began November 1, 1981. Your response to that request was forwarded by reference (c) in which the reporting interval was extended until January 8, 1982.

The additional sample data referred to in reference (b) was received from the vendor on schedule. However, one of the seven samples sent for analysis was reported to be depleted uranium. Our records show that this material is enriched uranium. This disparity has caused the Lynchburg Research Center to re-sample the batch of material in question. These samples are presently being analyzed but the results will not be reported to the Center in time to meet the January 8, 1982 deadline.

It is, therefore, necessary for me to request an extension of this reporting requirement to January 20, 1982.


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This should provide sufficient time for the results of the analysis to be received and the limit of error to be calculated.
