Dear Mr. Sullivan:

This is in response to your letter dated July 28, 1982 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, documents regarding California Salvage and U.S. Nuclear Corporation; WASH-734 and a microfiche copy of AEC - TR - 7308.

As explained during an August 11, 1982 telephone conversation with Mr. Stephen Isaacs of my staff, California Salvage of San Pedro, CA did have the authorization to dispose of radioactive waste in the ocean but did not exercise it. U.S. Nuclear Corporation of Burbank, CA was never authorized to dispose of radioactive waste in the ocean. As per that conversation, neither docket was reproduced.

A paper copy of WASH-734, "U.S. Sea Disposal Operations" and a microfiche copy of AEC - TR - 7308, "A Study of Artificial Radioactivity of the Atmosphere and Especially the Clouds" are enclosed.

This completes action on your request.
