NOTICE OF VIOLATION

U.S. Army Missile Command Redstone Arsenal

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License Nos. 01-00126-16 & 01-00126-17

As a result of the inspection conducted on June 29, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violations were identified.

A. License Condition 14.A of License No. 01-00126-17 requires that each sealed source containing licensed material shall be tested for leakage and/or contamination at intervals not to exceed six months.

Contrary to the above, the Perkin Elmer Nickel-63 sealed source previously leak tested on November 13, 1981, was not leak tested in May 1982 as required.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement VI).

B. License Condition 16 of License No. 01-00126-16 requires material be used in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in your application dated December 14, 1976. One procedure requires that your Radiation Control Committee meet on a guarterly basis.

Contrary to the above, the Radiation Control Committee has not met quarterly since May 1981.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violations; (2) the reasons for the violations if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
