Subject: Report No. 10-08389-03/82-11

This refers to your letter of August 18, 1982, responding to our letter and Notice of Violation dated July 26, 1982, concerning your NRC License No. 10-08389-03.

The information provided by your letter does not meet the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 in that responses were not provided for each violation as follows: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation, if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

You are requested to submit a supplementary response enumerating your responses as stated above, within ten days after receipt of this letter.

Furthermore, in reference to your comments regarding each violation, this office does not find these procedures to be acceptable alternatives to the health physics procedures required by your license, nor do your arguments represent acceptable justification for operating in noncompliance.
