Dear Mr. Sreniawski:

In response to the request in your letter of August 13, 1982, I now am able to advise you that we have achieved the actions that were outlined in my letter of July 29, 1982.

- 1) We have sent our Tracerlab gamma-ray sensitive survey meter to Nuclear Research Corp. for calibration and will plan to repeat this annually.
- 2) The Radiation Protection Officer, Richard D. Piccard, has performed surveys of our storage vault in August and September, with acceptable results. Surveys will be continued on a monthly basis.
- 3) A wipe test of our neutron source was conducted on September 8, 1982, following the procedure outlined in our application for license renewal. There was no indication of leakage at a sensitivity level below 0.0005  $\mu\text{Ci}$ .
