MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
IN RESPONSE TO APPLICANTS' MOTION
FOR SUMMARY DISPOSITION OF CFSP'S CONTENTION 26

This Board, in an Order dated July 6, 1982, admitted the Coalition for Safe Power's (CFSP) Contention 26.

The Applicant in its Motion for Summary Disposition points out that the basis for CFSP's Contention 26 was that Section 3.10 of the PSAR for S/HNP stated that the electrical and instrumentation equipment other than that supplied by General Electric would be seismically qualified in accordance with IEEE 341-1971.

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Subsequently, the PSAR for S/HNP has been amended and the Applicant has committed itself to meet the provisions of IEEE 344-1975 and NRC Regulatory Guide 1.100 for electrical instrumentation equipment supplied other than by GE.


It appears that Amendment 24 to the PSAR, Section 3.10.1.3.1 and the Applicants' answer to the NRC Staff Question 271.1 have mooted the issue raised by CFSP's Contention 26.


Accordingly, it is


ORDERED
