## SUBJECT:

QUESTIOLABLE COHDUCT BY NRC EIPLOYEES

In reference to your mienorandum dated July 30, 1979, subject as above, the Peport of Investigation into this ratter is attached. As indicated in the report, one of the allegations raised by your nenorandum was substantiated. Fore inportantly, however, a systenic weakness concerning the integrity of the investigative process is indicated. For exariple, there are no internal NRR procedures which (1) prohibit disclosing that an investigation is in progress or (2) which give guidance on when and how this prohibition should be invoked. Without such procedures, and given the apparent wide distribution of menoranda like the May 2, 1979, memorandur, it is belfeved that enployee misconduct in the future will be more difficult to substantiate, absent the most flagrant aployee conduct obviously calculated to help the target of the investigation.
