SUBJECT: TURKEY POINT UNIT 4 OVERPRESSURIZATION EVENTS IN
NOVEMBER 1981

Per your telecon on June 24, 1982, I am enclosing the following material related to the above subject:

- (1) A copy of the Westinghouse evaluation of the events - an internal Westinghouse memorandum from H. H. Bamford to J. C. Miller dated December 16, 1981.
- (2) A copy of correspondence dated December 18, 1981 from W. E. Cooper, Teledyne Engineering Services, to H. Paduano, Florida Power and Light Company, with the results of his review of the Westinghouse evaluation.
- (3) A copy of the February 2, 1982, inspection report on NRC - Region II's special inspection of the events - letter from J. P. O'Reilly to Dr. R. E. Uhrig same date.
- (4) A copy of R. E. Uhrig's response to item (3) dated March 4, 1982.
- (5) A copy of material prepared for an informal briefing of Commissioner Roberts on May 19, 1982, including two schematics of the plant systems involved, the applicable temperature-pressure limitations curve, several references from the technical specifications, and the results of fracture mechanics analyses made by P. N. Randall of NRR.

Per our conversation, you indicated that you already had copies of SECY 82-255, LER 251-81-15 and IE Information Notice No. 82-17; thus, I have not included those items.

At present, there is no completed AEOD engineering evaluation or case study for these events. An evaluation is planned, however.

The proposed abnormal occurrence report (i.e., the draft FRN) in SECY 82-255 reflects the comments and concurrence of NRR, IE, RES, and other NRC staff offices. In this case, the proposed abnormal occurrence report provides documentation of the NRC's current assessment of the significance of events. This is not an atypical situation as occasionally the abnormal occurrence reports precede other formal technical reports.
